All Pinewood Car Race Cars must be turned in prior to the beginning of the race. Registration will begin at 2:30 PM and the Pinewood Car Race will begin at 3:00 PM. Race time assignments will be made at time of car check-in. Competitor must be present at their scheduled race time in order to compete.



2017 Pinewood Car Race **Official Pinewood Car Race Rules**



Below are the rules for Eastern North Carolina Pinewood Car Race.

Each car will be inspected at weigh-in for the following inspection points:

Pinewood Car Race - Car Dimensions

- ◆ The overall length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
- ◆ The overall width of the car shall not exceed 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ inches.
- ◆ The car must have 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " clearance between the wheels.
- ◆ The car must have $\frac{3}{8}$ " clearance underneath the body (so it does not rub on the track).

Pinewood Car Race - Car Weight

- ◆ The car weight shall not exceed 5.0 ounces.
- ◆ The official race scale that is used at car check-in shall be considered final.

Wood, Wheels and Axles

- ◆ Pine wood block/kit may be purchased from anywhere.
- ◆ The block may be shaped in any way that is desired.
- ◆ Official Pinewood Car Race Wheels must be used. The wheels may not be cut, drilled, beveled or rounded. You may, however, remove the seams and imperfections from the wheels.
- ◆ All four wheels must remain in contact with the track for the duration of each race.
- ◆ The axles may not be altered except for the following: the axles may be polished and lubricated (dry lubricant only).

Car Modifications Not Allowed

- ◆ Wheel bearings, washers or bushings are prohibited.
- ◆ The car must not ride on any type of springs.
- ◆ No starting devices. The car must be freewheeling.
- ◆ No loose material of any kind, such as lead shot, may be used.

Other Pinewood Car Race Rules

- ◆ Once a car passes inspection and is entered into the race, only race committee members can touch it.
- ◆ If the car loses a wheel, or is otherwise damaged, the racer shall have 5 minutes to make a repair. The repaired car will be inspected to insure continued compliance with all rules.
- ◆ Each car must pass inspection by the official inspection committee before it will be allowed to compete.
- ◆ The Inspection Committee has the responsibility to disqualify those cars that do not meet these specifications. All decisions of the committee to qualify or disqualify cars are final.
- ◆ All cars must be presented to the Inspection Committee prior to the beginning of the race in order to be eligible to race.
- ◆ Competitor must be present at time of their scheduled race, all competitors not present when called for will be disqualified.
- ◆ Each competitor must have his own car. Cars cannot be shared between competitors.
