# Our Father Which Art in Heaven

---

- Form a mental picture of the blood shed by Jesus on the cross.
- Thank God that you can call Him “Father” by virtue of His blood.

# Hallowed Be Thy Name

---

- Benefit 1: Sin-forgiveness of sin and deliverance from sin's dominion.
  - Hallow His Name
    - Jehovah-tsidkenu: Jehovah Our Righteousness
    - Jehovah-m'kaddesh: Jehovah who Sanctifies
  - Make Your faith declarations.

# Hallowed Be Thy Name

---

- **Benefit 2: Spirit-fullness of the Holy Spirit**
  - Hallow His Name
    - Jehovah Shalom: Jehovah is Peace
    - Jehovah Shammah: Jehovah is There
  - Make Your Faith Declarations
- **Benefit 3: Soundness, Health, and Healing**
  - Hallow His Name
    - Jehovah-rophe: Jehovah Heals
  - Make your faith declarations.

# Hallowed Be Thy Name

---

- Benefit 4: Success-freedom From the Curse
  - Hallow His Name
    - Jehovah-jireh: God's provision shall be seen.
  - Make your faith declarations.

# Hallowed Be Thy Name

---

- Benefit 5: Security-freedom from the fear of Death & Hell
  - Hallow His Name
    - Jehovah-rohi: Jehovah my Shepherd
    - Jehovah-nissi: Jehovah my Banner
  - Make your faith declarations.

# Hallowed Be Thy Name

---

- Am I Taking the Lord's Name in Vain?
  - Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal areas in which you may be taking the Lord's name in vain.
  - Submit yourself to the Lordship of Christ. Pray in the Spirit. Worshipping and making melody in your heart.

# Thy Kingdom Come, Thy Will be Done

---

- Four major areas to establish His Kingdom:
  - Yourself
    - Be sure you are right before God.
    - Ask Jesus to be seated on the throne of your life and to rule in every area.
    - Abide before the Lord until the course of you day is set and the Spirit of God is functioning in you.
  - Your Family
    - Mate
    - Children
    - Other Family Members

# Thy Kingdom Come, Thy Will be Done

---

- Your church
  - Your Pastor
  - Leadership of the church
  - Faithfulness of the people
  - The Harvest
- Nation
  - City, State, and National political leaders
  - Spiritual Leaders
  - Revival

# Thy Kingdom Come, Thy Will be Done

---

- Ask The Spirit of God:
  - To implement your priorities.
  - To help you live them out.

# Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread

---

- Be in the will of God
  - Ask the Holy Spirit to help you develop a consistent daily personal prayer life and the time in the word where you fellowship daily with Jesus.
  - Pray that the Lord will plant you in your local church and make you a contributing, functioning, healthy part of the body.

# Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread

---

- Examine your work habits. Are you slothful? A workaholic? Ask the Lord to give you ability, efficiency, might, and balance.
- Examine your giving. Are you obeying the Lord in bringing your tithes and offerings into the store house? Do you pay your bills and have a reputation as a fair and honest person who keeps your word? Take time to pray along these lines.

# Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread

---

- **Believe it is God's Will to Prosper You**
  - Memorize Scripture such as Luke 6:38 & Philipians 4:19 to use as faith declarations as you pray in your provision.
  - Meditate upon the Word of God until you truly understand and believe it is God's will to bless you.
- **Be Specific**
  - Bring specific needs daily before God.
  - Decide to pray instead of worry

# Give Us This Day Our Daily Bread

---

## ■ Be tenacious

- Repossess lost ground the devil has stolen from you. Discouragement and unbelief have robbed you of answers to prayer. Take up those petitions again and persevere until the answer comes.
- Praise the Lord because He is Jehovah-jireh: He sees your need beforehand and makes provision.

# Forgive Us Our Debts

---

- Ask God to forgive you.
  - Deal with your sins. Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal areas in your life that are not pleasing to God.
  - Confess your sin. Agree with God and say what He says about your sin. Ask Him to help you hate your sin with perfect hatred and to deliver you from its dominion. Praise His name, Jehovah-m'kaddesh, "the Lord who Sanctifies".
  - Do not allow condemnation. Remember, you are the righteousness of God in Christ. You are complete in Him.

# As We Forgive Our Debtors

---

- Forgive as often as you want to be forgiven.
  - Meditate upon your great debt of sin that God has forgiven.
  - See your sin as actually causing Jesus' suffering on the cross. Get a mental picture of the blood shed for your forgiveness.
  - By an act of your will, forgive those who have sinned against you and release them to God. Pray for those who have wronged you.

# As We Forgive Our Debtors

---

- Set your will to forgive anyone who sins against you this day.
  - Make up your mind to return good for evil by the grace and power of the Holy Spirit within you.
  - Make this faith declaration: “I will love my enemies. I will bless them that curse me and do good to them that hate me. I will pray for them which despitefully use me and persecute me” (see Matthew 5:44).

# As We Forgive Our Debtors

---

- Pray that you will begin to experience the fruit of the Spirit in you, life in greater measure: love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, meekness, temperance, and faith (Gal. 5:22-23).

# Lead Us Not Into Temptation, But Deliver Us From Evil

---

- Put on the whole armor of God
  - Loins girded with truth
  - Breastplate of righteousness
  - Feet shod with preparation of the gospel
  - Shield of faith
  - Helmet of salvation
  - Sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of God

# Lead Us Not Into Temptation, But Deliver Us From Evil

---

- Build a hedge of protection
  - Three “because”:
    - Because we have made the Lord our habitation.
    - Because we have set our love upon Him.
    - Because we have known His name.
  - Declare “He is my refuge and fortress, my God, in Him will I trust.”

# For Thine is the Kingdom

---

- Praise the Lord because He has translated you out of the kingdom of darkness and into the kingdom of love and light.
- Make the faith declaration: “The Lord shall preserve me from every evil work and preserve me unto His Heavenly Kingdom”.
- Praise God because He has invited you to be a participant in His kingdom.

# The Power

---

- Praise the Lord because He has invited you to be a participant in His power.
- Meditate upon the power of God your Father. Measure your problems against His mighty, miraculous works and His great love for you.

# The Power

---

- Make this faith declaration: “I am strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. I have been endued with power from on high. Greater is He that is in me, than he that is in the world. My Father gives me strength and power to get wealth. He gives power to the faint. He keeps me by his power. He has given me power to tread on serpents and scorpions...”

# The Power

---

- ...and over all the power of the enemy.  
Nothing shall by any means harm me!”

# The Glory Forever

---

- Behold the Glory of the Lord- the character and ways of God exhibited through Jesus Christ. Ask the Holy Spirit to change you into the same image by forming Christ within you. Ask that you be transformed by the renewing of your mind.
- Ask the Lord to help you walk worthy of Him and to help you serve Him as He deserves to be served.
- Praise Him and give Him the Glory!!
