PK Retreat Fact Sheet

- ELIGIBILITY:** Eastern North Carolina Church of God Credentialed Ministers' Kids who are in Middle School and High School as of Fall 2026. To qualify to attend the PK Retreat the individual must be the child (natural, adopted, or through legal guardianship) of a minister credentialed with the Church of God and reporting to the Eastern North Carolina COG State Office, or be the child of a minister who serves (at least part-time paid) on staff at a local Eastern North Carolina Church of God congregation. (Executive/ Associate Pastor, Music/Worship Arts Pastor, Youth Pastor, Children's Pastor, Media Pastor, etc.)
- CHECK IN:** Registration / Check-in begins at 7:00 PM on Friday of the Retreat. PKs should not plan to arrive on the campground before this time. Please arrive on time!
- CHECK OUT:** We are heading back from Frankie's Saturday and plan to be back to the campground by 4:00 PM, getting lunch on the way. Parents please be on time for pick up!
- SCHEDULE:** Fun and Hang Out time at the Campground, Ice Cream Sundae Bar, Overnight Dorm Sleeping, A day of fun at Frankie's in Raleigh, NC. Also included are Breakfast & Lunch on Saturday, Snacks, Devotion Time, Connection with other PKs and more!
**Schedule is subject to change slightly.*
- CHAPERONES:** Cost for One (1) Chaperone per child will be covered by the ENC Youth & Discipleship Department. Any additional chaperones will need to cover their cost for food and fun park entry.
- MEDICINE:** Any necessary medications should be brought to the PK Retreat in their original container. All medications will be kept in the medical station and administered from there. By law, prescription medications can only be administered as prescribed.
- COST:** This is a COMPLETELY FREE EVENT, but you may bring money in case you would like to purchase anything else. Otherwise no money will be needed at this event.

PK Retreat Code of Conduct

1. All PK Retreat participants are expected to behave in a God-honoring manner at all times.
2. All PK Retreat participants are expected to attend all retreat activities unless excused by the State Y&D Director.
3. The dress code for the PK Retreat is simple: dress modestly.
4. All automobiles are to remain parked until the retreat is dismissed. No one may leave the grounds without written permission from the State Y&D Director.
5. All retreat participants will remain in their assigned dorm room after "lights out" and until "rise & shine."
6. Alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited. All medication brought to the PK Retreat must be left with the retreat medical personnel.
7. Please do not bring fireworks, lighters, firearms, knives or other weapons, these are not allowed.

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THINGS TO BRING

- Appropriate Clothes (refer to the code of conduct dress code)
 - Twin-sized bedding for bunks including sheets and pillows/pillowcases
 - Towels and Washcloths
 - Toiletries (soap, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, deodorant...)
 - Plastic bag for dirty clothes
 - Sweater/Light Jacket
 - Comfortable walking shoes
 - Medication in original container inside a zip lock bag
 - Bible, Notebook, and Pen
 - LOTS OF EXCITEMENT!!!!
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THINGS NOT TO BRING

- Alcohol and Illegal Drugs
 - Tobacco in any form
 - Firearms, Knives, Weapons
 - Fireworks, lighters
 - Anything expensive
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PLEASE NOTE

Anyone driving to the PK Retreat will be expected to park his or her vehicle in the designated parking area. All vehicles must remain parked until the individual driver has checked out at the conclusion of the PK Retreat.

Anyone leaving the campground without permission will immediately be dismissed from the PK Retreat.
