Elevate Conference Fact Sheet

- DESCRIPTON:** Elevate is an amazing student conference designed to disciple our students and equip them to express Christ. This 24-hour encounter is for High School and Middle School students. Bishop Max Reyes will be our guest speaker, and the worship will be led by none other than ENC United. Throughout Saturday morning, we will have multiple breakout sessions to help shape our sons and daughters for the work of ministry. Breakfast and lunch will be provided, the concessions stand will be open on Friday night, and the camp store will be available for refreshments. There will be plenty of activities and lots of fun. This is a weekend that unlocks purpose and instills hope into the lives of our students.
- CHECK IN:** Registration / Check-in begins at 5:30 PM on Friday of the conference. Participants should not plan to arrive on the campground before this time. Please arrive on time!
- CHECK OUT:** After the conclusion of the final service on Saturday afternoon, conference dismissal will be around 5:00 PM. Parents please be on time for pick up!
- SCHEDULE:** Activities include services and worship, freetime, overnight dorm sleeping, and breakout sessions. Also included are breakfast & lunch on Saturday, snacks, concessions, connection with other students and more!

- LEADERS:** The cost is \$40 per leader. However, the cost of One (1) leader for every 10 students that register as a group will be covered by the ENC Youth & Discipleship Department.
- MEDICINE:** Any necessary medications should be brought to the Elevate Student Conference in their original container. All medications will be kept in the medical station and administered from there. By law, prescription medications can only be administered as prescribed.
- COST:** The cost is \$40 per person. For every 10 students that registers as a group, one leader is free.

Elevate Student Conference Code of Conduct
