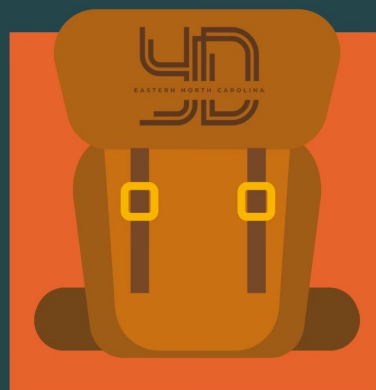

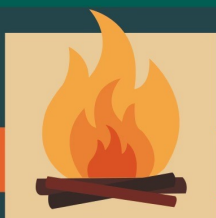

CAMPSITE COMPETITION

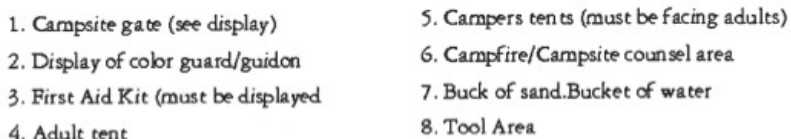
Camp Sites will be judged on the following set of rules:
Each will be scored on a scale of 1-10, with 10 being the best score.

Total 100 points possible!

- 1. CAMPSITE CLEANLINESS:** The campsite should be neat and organized, free of debris, with no food left out.
- 2. CAMPSITE LAYOUT:** Tents should be uniform (straight line, semi-circled, square, etc.). Campfire should be a safe distance from tents (8-10 ft.). If you build a fire, you must remove the sod and replace the sod at the end of the camp or build your fire off the ground.
- 3. TENT APPEARANCE:** Tents should be set up properly. Make sure tents are tight and properly staked down.
- 4. INTERIOR TENT CONDITION:** The inside of the tent WILL BE CHECKED. Leave door flaps open so judges can look in without entering the tent. Sleeping bags are rolled up or laid out neatly (rolled up is best so they don't get walked on), and clothes and personal items are put away. Be clean and neat.
- 5. CAMP CRAFT:** Items or equipment built to make the campsite more efficient or just to make the campsite look better.
- 6. IDENTIFICATION OF CAMPSITE:** Have some type of sign or banner with a name, unit #, etc. Also, display your flags.
- 7. CAMP SAFETY:** Make camp as safe as possible. The first aid kit should be visible and easily accessible. Make sure things aren't left where it is easy to trip over. Practice fire safety.
- 8. PIONEER SPIRIT:** Does your campsite have that rustic look and feel of the true camping spirit, or does it look like the ladies just moved out?
- 9. GENERAL APPEARANCE:** Overall, how does it look?
- 10. BONUS AWARD:** Bonus points will be given for things that are very unique or eye-catching.
